Q: How do I get hold of a Lapel pin?

A: Once you have signed up for Regular Giving by Direct Debit, these are free and will be given to you by your Festival Steward.

Q: Where do I get a Little Ted?

A: Each Lodge has been allocated their own and will have been giving to the WM by your Hall Coordinator.

Q: How do I get a Festival Jewel?

A: Once you have pledged to give by regular giving, or donated £400 (including gift aid if applicable) then you need to fill in the form available on the website (or email info@festival2022.org.uk), send off your £16.50 and your Jewel will be sent back to you.

Q: What about other honorifics?

A: All other honorifics (Vice Patron at £750, Patron at £1000 and Grand Patron at £1250) will be conferred automatically by certificate/Letter. There are no bars to Jewels.

Q: Who gets the credit on Gift Aid Envelopes?

A: Irrespective of the lodge number that you put on the envelope, when you fill in an E2022 gift aid envelope at a Lodge meeting, the LODGE THAT YOUR ARE AT will get the LODGE CREDIT, however YOU AS AN INDIVIDUAL will ALSO get the same credit towards your own honorific.
