FESTIVAL JEWEL APPLICATION

Dear Brother.

The Provincial Grand Lodge of Worcestershire enters its 2022 Festival Appeal in aid of the Masonic Charitable Foundation on Saturday 21st January 2017. It will be launched by the R. W. Provincial Grand Master at an event immediately following the 6889 Installed Masters meeting that afternoon.

Although not launched yet some brethren already qualify for personal honorific's, having pledged by regular giving or donated the following amounts:

- a) FESTIVAL STEWARD £400 (£320 where gift aid is to be added otherwise £400)
- b) VICE PATRON £750 (£600 where gift aid is to be added otherwise £750)
- c) PATRON £1,000 (£800 where gift aid is to be added otherwise £1,000)
- d) GRAND PATRON £1,250 (£1,000 where gift aid is to be added otherwise £1,250)

Those who've donated or pledged a minimum of £400 qualify to wear the Festival Jewel from launch. Those achieving higher levels will be recognised by the Festival Committee and Certificate from the R. W. Provincial Grand Master. The jewel cost is £15 plus £1.50 postage so please complete the application and send it to: -
